Year 3 BA (Hons) Historic Carving: Stone

"Despite having received the stone for the project almost two months later than planned, I have managed to get through the initial roughing out process relatively quickly by using a pneumatic air chisel for the first stage of carving. I am currently on course to be finished by early April, provided everything goes smoothly! As I am not using a pointing machine to copy exactly from the cast, the carving has taken on a few slight changes in appearance. Using the strength of the limestone, I have been able to add more height to certain areas of the relief which was not possible when making the clay model version. I believe this adds a lot more character to the piece and will really aid in drawing the viewer in to the scene in its completed form."
